Zero Waste's UK Engineering Partner launches Royal Project

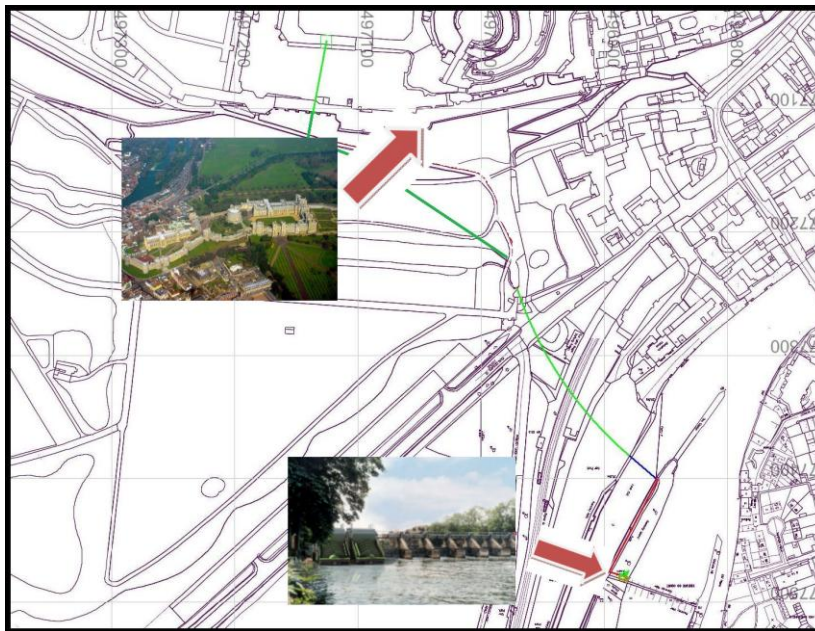
